Guidelines for Blogging at From Homily to Home

Your participation in this premier St. Jerome blogging experience is evidence that you have read the guidelines and agreed to abide by them. The success of this unique evangelizing and faith-deepening experience is dependent of your compliance with these guidelines:

- 1. Think deeply about Sunday's readings and Father Raj's homily and make connections to your life as you write comments on the Blog, *From Homily to Home*. Connect to other's comments and to information and daily applications that you have learned about our Catholic faith.
- 2. I plan to generate conversations on Sundays. Post as often as you desire throughout the week as you reflect on the Sunday readings and homily.
- 3. Reflect on my conversation-starter or directly on the Sunday readings and homily before you submit a reflective comment that contains at least 30 words. Your investment of this minimum number of words assures that others may be able to "spin off" of your thoughts.
- 4. Remember that our goal is to be informative about who we are as learners and to support one another's faith journeys.
- 5. If you quote or refer to someone else's ideas, photos, music, or videos, give them credit. Also be sure to reference Catholic sources, if you decide to enhance your blog with citations.
- 6. Be ethical and refer to others in our parish in such a way as to protect confidentiality rights.
- 7. Strive to achieve the goal of this *From Homily to Home* blogging experience which is to deepen and strengthen the ties between Sunday's liturgy and the weekdays of our daily lives.
